Random Drug Testing rate - As shown below, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration has lowered the percentage of drivers that must be tested for controlled substances from 50% to 25% for the year 2016. This reduction is the result of FMCSA policy that allows a reduction in the percentage to be tested for controlled substances if the actual positive rate falls below 1% for two consecutive years. It has been below 1% for the past 3 years. If the positive rate were to exceed 1% in any future year, the testing rate would revert to 50% for the following year.

The testing rate for alcohol for 2016 remains at 10%
